


Share real-time events instantly with the latakoo mobile app. Stream video live to the latakoo cloud, where it can be viewed, clipped, transcribed in real time. The feed is recorded in both latakoo Pilot and your mobile device.

How to Live Stream

- 1. Open the latakoo mobile app and login
- 2. Click Capture at the bottom of the screen
- 3. Toggle to LIVE STREAM (BETA)
- 4. (Optional) Click on the settings icon in the upper left corner to adjust your live stream settings:
 - Resolution
 - BitRate mode we recommend Auto
 - Flash
 - Enable Audio
 - \cdot Enable Video
 - Stream Name: give your file a unique, descriptive name; you can rename the stream after finishing
 - Stream to: select the network(s) where you are sending the live stream
 - . Timer
- 5. Click GO LIVE to begin streaming
- 6. Click the stop button to finish live streaming
- 7. (Optional) Rename the file and click save



(Optional) While you are live streaming, you can adjust the following:

- Flash
- Enable Audio
- Enable Video
- Zoom
- Capture a photo while streaming
- \cdot Flip which camera you are streaming from



Live streams can be viewed in real time on latakoo.com, marked with a red **LIVE** icon. Streams can be played from the beginning, viewed live, and edited to create new clips as they continue to stream. Live transcription will also appear as the steam progresses.

Once finished, the stream will behave as a regular upload in Pilot. Currently, for the stream to continue to latakoo HUB and use an asset manager workflow, the stream must end.
