


## Stitch Uploads

Upload files as a stitch to string them together into one long file in the cloud. Stitches work for **like files (same orientation, frame rates, format, number of audio tracks, etc...). They are not guaranteed to work if you attempt to stitch files with different properties.**

## Desktop App

1. Open the latakoo app and click the upload method link (will say Individual, Group, Group-Stitch, or Maintain Folder Structure depending on your default settings)
2. Set Upload As to **Group-Stitch**
3. Click **Save**
4. Drag any files you would like to upload as a stitch into the app
  - Currently, you can only upload **video** files as a stitch in the desktop app
5. Click **Stitch Settings** to name your Stitch and click **Okay**
6. Optional: rename your individual files, adjust the network destination and upload quality
  - You must use some level of compression when uploading a stitch in the desktop app
7. Click **Start**
8. When uploading as a group, you will see an **S** in the progress indicator circle



Once your stitch lands in Pilot, it will appear with a “stitch” label. If connected to a Hub, the full stitched file will be ingested into your asset manager.

When you open a stitch in Pilot, you can view all individual files within the stitch, or the full stitch.


1. Each file will have its own details, metadata, and transcription
2. Metadata can also be synced across all files within the stitch
3. The entire group of files, including the full stitch and individual clips, can be downloaded via the latakoo desktop app
4. Any file, including the full stitch, can be downloaded individually

## Mobile App

1. Open the latakoo app and go to the **Library** tab
2. Select the files you want to upload as a stitch by clicking them
  - You can stitch together **all video** or **all audio** files in the mobile app

- If you select videos of different orientations, frame rates, or audio tracks, you will get a warning that latakoo cannot guarantee the stitch will be successful; we suggest you group upload files with different properties instead

3. Click **Send**
4. Select **Upload As Stitch** and click **Done**
5. Name the Stitch under Title & Keywords
6. Optional: adjust the network destination and upload quality
7. Click **Send**



In the mobile app, Once your stitch lands in Pilot, it will appear as a regular video upload. The full stitch can be viewed and downloaded. On Pilot on the web, you can view and download all individual files within the stitch, or the full stitch as described above.

## Stitching Best Practices

Always upload **files with the same properties...**

- Same format
- Same quality (i.e. 4k vs cinematic vs 1080p)
- Same orientation
- Same frame rates

- Same number of audio tracks

When in doubt - upload a group instead.

There is no limit to number of files, length, or size that you can stitch, but remember your bandwidth constraints and network conditions can impact a long stitch upload. If even one file in the stitch is effected, the whole stitch will be effected.
