


## How to Judge NPPA's TV Quarterly Clip Contest

4. Click **Apply to join this video organization**


### Login and Score the Submissions

2. Select the **Contest** you will be judging in the top drop down menu
3. Click into a category (group of files) to play the videos and give your scores




4. Add your score for each video using the drop down menu with your judge number
